It's equally effective in removing decals like registration numbers. Release helps remove vinyl and takes care of residue from labels and masking tape, even when they've been sunbaked onto the surface.

BoatLIFE Release is safe to use on most carpeted, vinyl, plastic and painted surfaces. With low VOCs, it can be used above or below deck.

Using BoatLIFE Release Adhesive & Sealant Remover is simple. It's sprayed along the edge of the sealant or decal or directly onto the remaining residue, then worked with a plastic scraper to loosen and remove.
